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## RESPECTIVE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND PRINCIPAL IN RELATION TO ADMISSIONS

The Board of Governors draws up the admissions criteria and delegates to the Principal, the responsibility for applying these criteria. Any reference herein to the term the Board of Governors includes the Principal appointed by the Board of Governors for the purposes of applying the admissions criteria.

## ADMISSION TO PRIMARY ONE AND RECEPTION CLASS

If the school's admission and enrolment numbers have not been reached the school will admit all children of the appropriate age whose parents wish them to attend the school. These children are: -

- i firstly those of compulsory school age (children who reach their fourth birthday on or before 1 July 2022); then
- ii those who reach their fourth birthday between 2 July and 31 October 2022 (both dates inclusive); then
- iii those who reach their fourth birthday after 1 November 2022 will be admitted by arrangement with the Principal.

Children in categories ii and iii will only be selected for admission if places are not filled by children in category i.

## ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria <u>punctual applications</u> will be considered before <u>late</u> <u>applications</u> are considered. The application procedure opens on 10 January 2022 at 12noon (GMT) and an application submitted by the closing date of 28 January 2022 at 12noon (GMT) will be treated as a <u>punctual application</u>. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 28 January 2022 will be treated as a <u>late application</u>.

Children who are not of compulsory school age will only be selected for admission after all children of compulsory school age have been allocated a place.

The Principal will apply the following criteria in the order indicated to identify which children should be admitted either at initial admission to education or on transfer from another school.

- 1. Children of compulsory school age who have a sibling (brother/sister, half-brother/sister, step brother/sister including those fostered or adopted) presently at Our Lady's.
- 2. Children of compulsory school age who normally reside in the Tullysaran area of Armagh Parish.
- 3. Children of compulsory school age from other areas.
- 4. Children who reach their fourth birthday between 2 July and 31 October 2022 (both dates inclusive).
- 5. Children who reach their fourth birthday after 1 November 2022.

In the event of over-subscription in any one of the criteria, taken in order, the following sub-criteria will be applied in the order set down. If oversubscribed in any of the sub-criteria, taken in order, final selection will be on the basis of closeness of the home to the school as measured by the shortest driving distance by public road priority being given to those living nearest the school.

(a) Children who have a sibling (brother/sister, half-brother/sister, step brother/sister including those fostered or adopted) presently at Our Lady's.

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- (b) Children who normally reside in the Tullysaran area of Armagh Parish.
- (c) Children whose parent/guardian, sibling (brother/sister, half-brother/sister, step brother/sister including those fostered and adopted) was a past pupil of Our Lady's Tullysaran or Tullysaran or Tullymore old primary schools.
- (d) Children whose parent/guardian is presently a permanent member of the school teaching/ancillary/auxiliary staff.
- (e) Preference will be given to children with exceptional circumstances (medical, social or other problems) that necessitate admission to Our Lady's Primary School, Tullysaran rather than any other primary school. The circumstances should be personal to the child and must be supported by independent and appropriate documentation, providing evidence of the circumstances being described as being exceptional.
- (f) Chronological age with the oldest child first.
- (g) Alphabetical order using surname (on the birth certificate) only.
- (h) Other children.

### DUTY TO VERIFY

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any application.

If the requested evidence is not provided to the Board of Governors by the deadline given, this will result in the withdrawal of an offer of a place. Similarly, if information is supplied which appears to be false or misleading in any material way, the offer of a place will be withdrawn.

#### WAITING LIST POLICY

If oversubscribed, parents can request in writing for their child to be placed on a waiting list for admission. The order will be determined by the date the request is received.

### ADMISSION TO P2-P7

Pupils will be admitted to other classes provided the total number of pupils in classes P2 – P4 does not exceed 30 pupils or 32 pupils in P5 – P7 classes.
