School reports and children's books will be available for **collection** for all children on **Friday 19th June**. Parents should also **return all reading and library books** that have been sent home over the past few months in the Home Schooling packs. It is vitally important that all books are returned to school as they will be used to support children's learning next year. The teachers have kept a record of all the books that have been sent home and the school will have to be reimbursed for any books that are not returned.

The reports will be organised into family groups, with collection from the class your eldest child is in. Designated time for collection will therefore be as per your eldest child's class. If the weather is dry, we will have the reports and books outside and if not they will be in the foyer. We would ask you to be mindful of social distancing when arriving to collect the reports from school. Please come on your own, include your child(ren)'s name(s) on the books you are returning and bring a sturdy carrier bag so that you can collect the children's books. The times for collection are as follows: **P1 & P2: 11-12 noon; P3 & P4: 12-1 pm and P5-P7: 1pm-3pm**. If these times are not suitable please call the school on Friday morning to make alternative arrangements.

Mrs Mc Anallen will be available on Friday if you need to settle any outstanding bills. The school has enclosed cheques in some of the P7 children's reports and vouchers will be available for other families that can be used or cashed in next year.

I hope to see you on Friday; it will just be Mrs Comiskey and I overseeing the collection of school reports. Please contact the school if you have any queries, suggestions or concerns. Thank you.
