Special mention must go to the Primary 3 parents and school staff who: prepared food, set-up the hall, served refreshments for the after party and tidied up the community centre. Confirmation: On Sunday 5th June our Primary 7 children made their Confirmation in St. Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh. The children were confirmed by Archbishop Martin in a very spiritual celebration and the children were all excellent. Thanks to everyone who assisted with the preparation of the children for Confirmation and all of the families for their support.

Green Flag Award: Our school were recently awarded the prestigious Eco Schools Green flag award, for the third time. This is a tremendous achievement for our Eco Council and Ms Loughran who have completed excellent environmental work over the last two years, including: providing free reusable water bottles for every child, hosting a litter poster competition in conjunction with Tullysaran O'Connells GAC, ABC Council and Benburb Spar. We are delighted to receive this fantastic award as we aim to promote the importance of protecting our environment.

Parent Survey: Each year we review the progress made in the children's learning and the school's development, identifying areas of focus for continued development in the future. Pupil Reports: Teachers are currently completing the children's reports and they will be sent home at the end of June. Please ensure that all school reading books and materials are returned to school before the end of June. Thanks.

Parent Pay: We continue to use Parent Pay to facilitate cashless payments however cash payments may be accepted on some occasions. Please ensure that you keep your payments up to date on Parent Pay to assist us in the smooth running of our school. Thank you.

Primary 6 Summer Transfer Camp: Unfortunately, the Department of Education has not provided funding for schools to offer Summer Schemes this year. However we would like to offer a one week Transfer Camp for Primary 6 children from Monday 25th until Friday 29th July. The camp will run from 9am-12noon but will be dependent on a minimum of ten children attending at a cost of £30 per child. A letter will be sent home to Primary 6 parents next week.

New Vice-Principal: I am delighted to inform you that Mr Aidan Forker has been offered the post of Vice-Principal in our school. Mr Forker, currently teaches in St. John's Primary School, Kings Island, and is a member of the Armagh Gaelic football team. Aidan is a highly regarded teacher with excellent experience and we look forward to welcoming him to our school community.
