School uniform will remain the same next year with **plain black footwear (shoes or runners)** and plain navy trousers/tracksuit bottoms or skirts/pinafores permitted in school. Girls should wear navy tights or navy knee high socks. Children may wear plain navy shorts or blue checked summer dress with white socks in September and in the third term. Tracksuit bottoms with logos and coloured trainers will not be permitted. Hair accessories should be kept to a minimum. Please ensure that your child wears full school uniform.

Application forms for free school meals, school transport and uniform grants for 2019/20 are now available on the Education Authority website. It is very important that you register your child for free school meals even if they take lunches as the school receives extra funding from the Department of Education for children who are eligible for free school meals.
